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Care Management General Information

Gold Coast Health Plan provides RN and LCSW Care Management services for our members.

Examples of members that may benefit from GCHP Care Management services may include:

- Complex history and has complex care needs
- Multiple co-morbidities
- Prescribed more than 15 medications
- Member unable to navigate the health systems
- Member lacks understanding GCHP benefits
- Member needs linkage with community resources
- There are barriers to care
- Unsafe living conditions
- Member does not have a caregiver/support system/lives alone
- Member unable to perform ADL's and IADLs safely, with or without assistance
- There have been 3 or more hospital admissions in the past 6 months
- Expectation that the member may be readmitted to the hospital within 30 days
- There have been more than 3 ER visits in the past 6 months
- Member exhibits depression, anxiety, or has a psychological comorbidity
- Current DME or assistive device is not appropriate
- Transplants
- Children who do not qualify for CCS coverage but have any of the above qualifiers
- High Risk obstetrical members 35 weeks and below
- Cases that do not meet any of the above criteria but are of such intensity they warrant clinical care management and scrutiny
