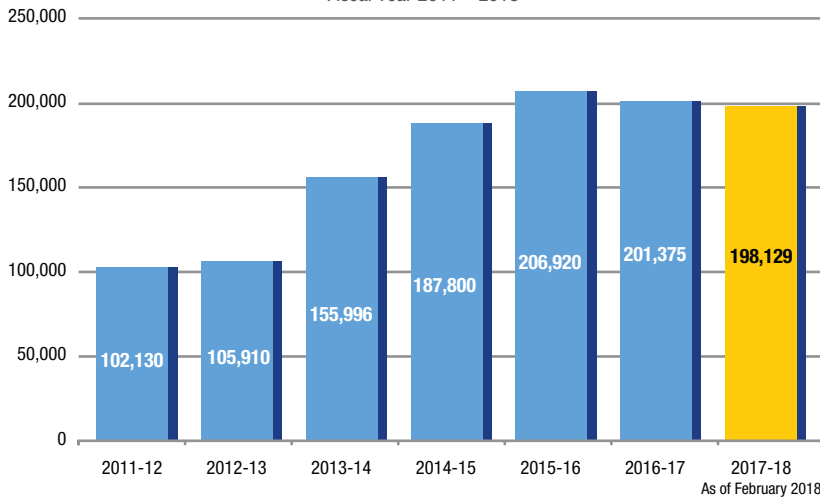

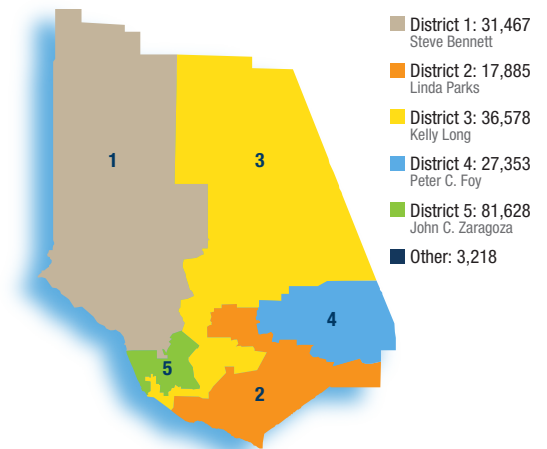

GCHP Membership Growth

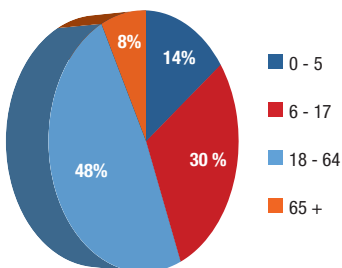
Fiscal Year 2011 – 2018



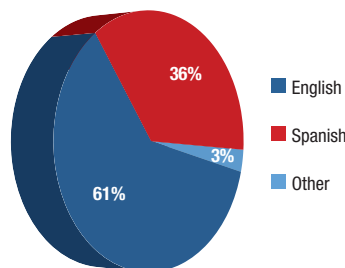
Membership by Supervisorial District



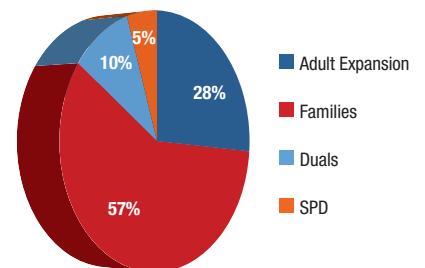
Member Age
